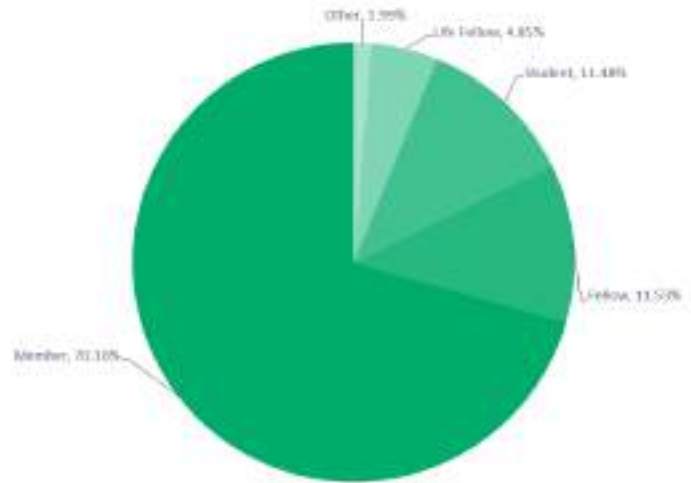

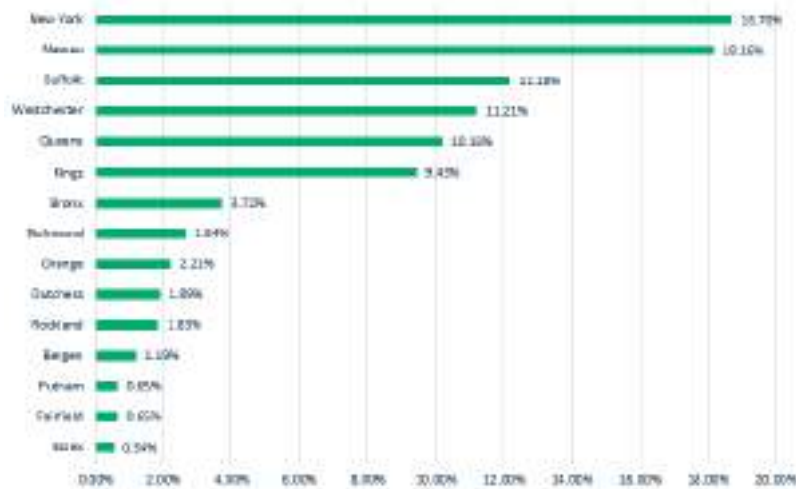
Membership by Title

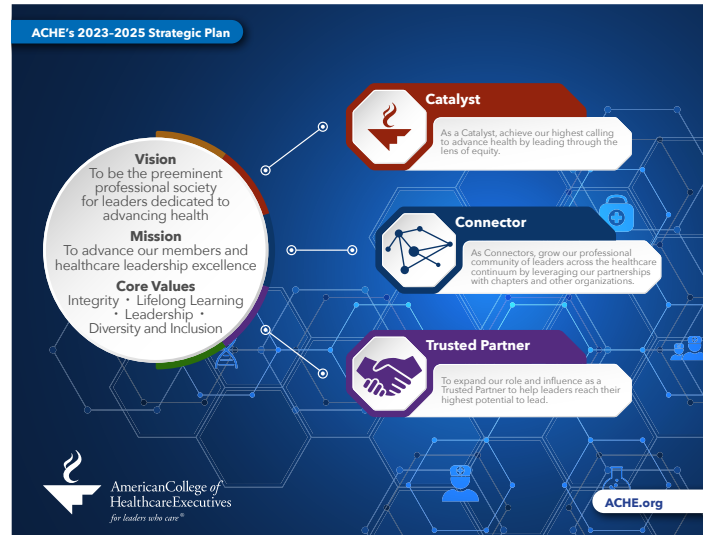

# ACHE RECOGNITION PROGRAM

The American College of Healthcare Executives (ACHE) Recognition Program celebrates members commitment to the healthcare management profession. Recognition is bestowed at three levels based on a range of specific volunteer activities that demonstrate leadership and contributions to furthering professional excellence. All active ACHE members are eligible to be recognized.

The ACHE Recognition Program is based on points accrued through volunteer activities performed in a convocation year (April–March). Points begin to accrue for members beginning with the 2003–2004 convocation year and are cumulative from year to year. A member does not need to achieve a set number of points in a single year, but rather points will build over time. In that manner, members have the opportunity to progress through the three award levels.

## The three award levels are:

- **Exemplary Service Award** = 125 points
- **Distinguished Service Award** = 75 points
- **Service Award** = 30 points

Of the 1,800+ HLNy members, 88 members received 1-star/Service award, 18 members received 2-stars, Distinguished award and 7 members received 3-stars/Exemplary Service award.
