#### **Professional Biography**

Ms. Browning is a fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives, past president of Healthcare Leaders of New York, and also served as an examiner with the United States Department of Commerce Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award Program. As an active community leader, Ms. Browning serves on the Board of Directors of Hudson Valley Pattern for Progress and is the elected Treasurer of the Healthcare Association of New York State.




## **Stephanie Wang, MD, FACHE**Professional Biography


